*P*aul Hasenmeier, Sunset Beach Fire Chief, has more than twenty years of fire and emergency services experience.



He resides in Ocean Isle Beach with his wife Amanda, and their three daughters Kylie, Kennedy, and Khloe.

Hasenmeier possesses a bachelor’s degree in Fire Science from Columbia Southern University as well as a master’s degree in Public Administration from Capella University. He is a graduate of the National Fire Academy’s Executive Fire Officer Program. Additionally, Hasenmeier is trained as a firefighter, paramedic, instructor, fire inspector, and in all of National Fire Protection Association 1670 Standard technical rescue disciplines (structural collapse, trench, confined space, high angle, vehicle extrication, swift water, ice, surf, and scuba diving). Chief Hasenmeier was a member of a regional urban search and rescue team in Ohio from its inception in the post 9/11 era until 2015. These experiences included deployment to a plane crash in Lake Erie, a structural collapse at a factory, and responses to tornado and other weather related disasters.

Chief Hasenmeier has more than twenty-five published articles related to fire rescue, emergency services, and leadership related topics. Over the years he has completed research related to topics on: Organizational Analysis and Leadership, Municipal Accounting and Finance Analysis, Leaders Fear of Education, Organization Strategic Planning, Social Media Policy and Regulated Use, The Role of Local Government in Natural Disasters, Human Resource Management Audit of Fire Departments, and Trainings Affect on Organizational Morale.

In addition to his current duties and responsibilities as fire chief in Sunset Beach, Hasenmeier is a faculty member at Columbia Southern University where he teaches on-line courses in their fire administration program. Hasenmeier is an adjunct instructor for Bowling Green State University and teaches at their annual state fire school. Hasenmeier has presented on fire service and leadership topics across the United States and in Canada.
