In keeping with guidance we received, we reduced the size of the Memorial to 908 square feet. This size will allow us to maintain our vision to produce a simple and elegant Memorial. We also moved the flag pole from the Memorial proper to insure that if this area is racked with a heavy storm and the pole is damaged, repairs can be made without damaging the Memorial.

What we are now asking the Council to do is to approve the Veteran's Memorial project at the recommended location in the Sunset Beach Park. The positive vote will enable us to go forward with the project. Once approved, we will begin to raise funds, talk to donors, businesses and others to help us get the project finished. The project will not seek any tax payer dollars for the Memorial.

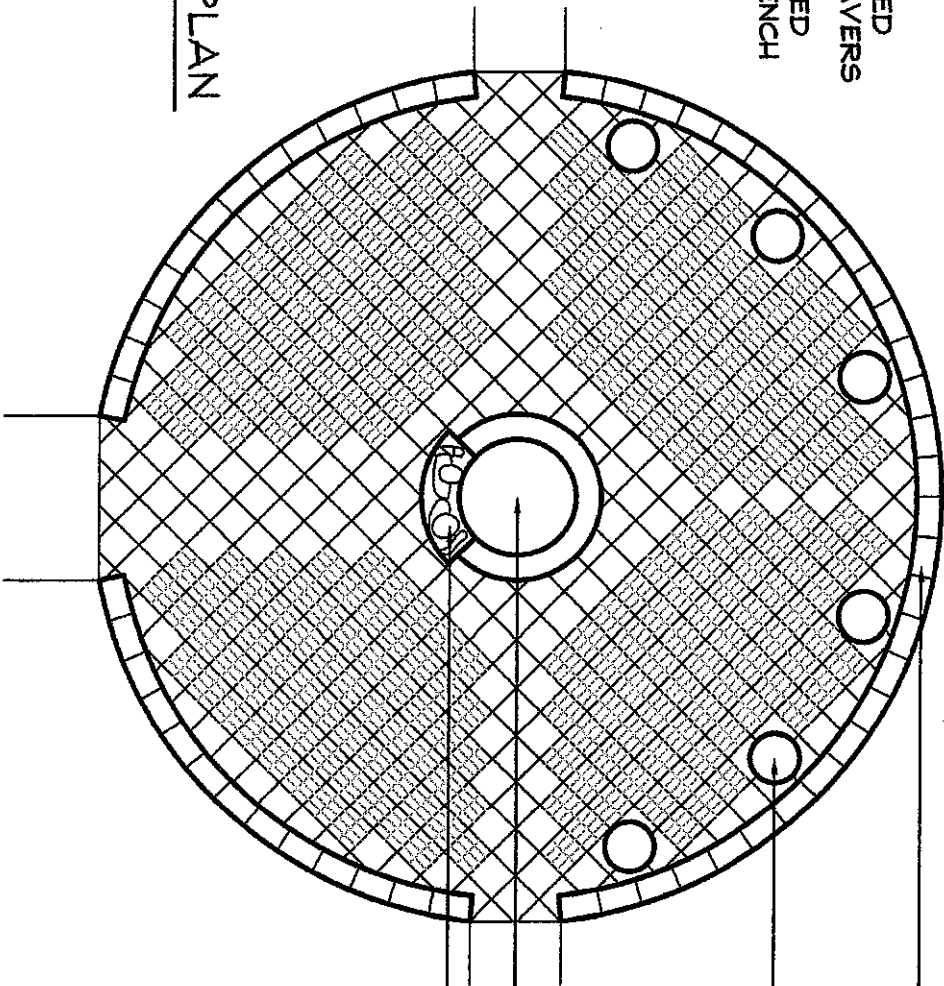
