

Honoring America's Veterans Building a Veterans' Memorial



To be located in the Sunset Beach Town Park, Brunswick County, North Carolina



WWW.SBVETS.ORG HonorAmericasVeterans@gmail.com he Committee to Honor America's Veterans is a group of residents of Brunswick County dedicated to constructing a Veterans' Memorial in our region. Some of us have served our country while others are citizens who support our veterans.

Our vision is to build a memorial for Brunswick County — one brick at a time — in the Sunset Beach Town Park on land donated by the Town of Sunset Beach. The memorial will be in an idyllic setting in the Park overlooking the Intracoastal Waterway. It will commemorate and properly recognize our veterans — past, present, and future — for their contributions to the protection of our nation and its citizens, as well as the preservation of freedom throughout the world. We see the memorial as a serene and dignified place where veterans and civic organizations may hold ceremonies and where individuals may come and reflect.

The memorial will be an approximately 900 square feet, circular design with a flag pole for the US flag, pedestals for Service emblems, and, in the center, a circular marble or granite topped column with a map of the world representing the presence of US military across the globe. In front of that column facing the flag, we plan to mount a bronze statue of two children with a phrase along the lines of "thanks for our freedom."

The exterior wall of the Memorial will be 18" high and level with places for visitors to sit while they rest and contemplate the significance of the sacrifices and contributions our veterans have made. The flooring will consist of clay bricks of varying sizes.
